

Book Care Rules

1. Don't bend or tear the pages of your library book. Mark your place in a book with a clean, flat bookmark.
2. Keep books clean and dry. Don't put them near food or drinks.
3. Look at books with clean dry hands.
4. Never write, scribble, or glue on the pages of the book. Don't cut or trace the pages. In case of an accident, let the librarian know. Librarians have special tape and glue that can repair some damages.
5. Turn the pages carefully from the top corner.
6. Always carry your books to and from school in a backpack or book bag.
7. Keep your books in a safe place at home where little brothers, sisters, or pets cannot harm them.
8. Please remember to return your books to the library on time.
