Mhat is the AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT?



As part of the federal government's American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act, school districts across the country will receive additional funding to support student need in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic. The Pine Valley Central School District will receive an allocation of about 2.6 million to invest in our students' education over the next three years. This is a once in a generation infusion of funds that gives us the opportunity to support students in a variety of ways!

Community Needs!

Planning to use these funds has commenced in collaboration with District students, staff, families, and community members.

To gather feedback and input, the PVCSD created multiple opportunities for all stakeholders to engage with District staff and share their ideas and needs.

Careful consideration of community priorities are being taken into account as the District creates a plan to move forward.

Community Needs!

We identified our community needs in a variety of ways:

- Utilized several community surveys to gauge early learning needs, return to school concerns, and engage in ways to address learning loss.
- Held committee meetings to engage various stakeholders
- Collaborated with members of our PVCSD Board of Education, instructional team, and non instructional team.
