The next step in our long-range capital improvement initiative is based on the following focus areas of health and safety, asset preservation, and educational program spaces. The categories below list some general items the Board of Education has identified and is considering for the next proposed capital improvement project:



Health, Safety, and **Security Improvements**

- Sanitary piping and water mitigation improvements
- Reconstruction of deteriorated walkways and parking areas
- Pedestrian and vehicle safety/ circulation improvements
- ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) accessibility upgrades
- HVAC and air-handling systems



Educational Program Space Improvements

- Auditorium seating and equipment improvements
- Restroom upgrades and locker room privacy enhancements
- Kitchen improvements
- Sidewalk and driveway improvements for access to the new playground



Building Infrastructure and Asset Preservation

- Replacement of systems and equipment at end of useful life
- Window and door replacements
- Mechanical, electrical, and plumbing system upgrades
- Fencing replacement
- Site drainage improvements
- Transportation, maintenance, and storage facility upgrades
