

Principal Incentive Days

Aim to promote high achievement, regular attendance, and remarkable behavior throughout the year.

How many Principal Incentive Days are there?

- There are 2 Principal Incentive Days.
- 1 per semester (1st and 2nd Quarters= 1 semester). The second Principal Incentive Day will include the criteria below through the 6-week mark of the 4th quarter (All of the 3rd and 6 weeks of the 4th Quarter).

How do students earn a Principal Incentive Day?

- Students who have earned Honor Roll (90% or higher GPA) for the entire semester will earn the trip.
- Students must have missed five or fewer days per semester (unexcused).
- Students must be tardy to school five or fewer days per semester (unexcused).
- Students must be dismissed early from school five or fewer days per semester (unexcused).
- No behavioral write-ups for the semester.

How will students be notified that they earned a Principal Incentive Day?

- They will be called to the auditorium shortly after the semester ends/6-week mark of the 4th quarter to let them know what they earned.
- Permission slips will be sent home.

Incentive Days

Aim to promote good behavior and academic standing.

How many Incentive Days are there?

- There are four Incentive Days.
- One per quarter.

How does a student earn an Incentive Day (must meet all three)?

- At the 6-week mark, a student cannot be on Mandatory Guided Study (meaning they are not failing two or more classes).
- No more than six full-day unexcused absences by the end of the warning week.
- A student must have no more than two write-ups within that quarter.
- A student must not have received ISS or OSS within that guarter.
