## Pine Valley Elementary School Supply List 2020-2021 Grades K-6

The following is a <u>general</u> list of supplies by grade level. Individual teachers may require additional supplies and if that is the case, parents will be notified by the teacher. Don't forget to <u>label everything</u>. NO TRAPPER KEEPERS — Desk openings are only 4" high and will not accommodate them. Please remember this when purchasing pencil/supply boxes as well. Book bags on wheels have become popular, however, most do not fit into the size lockers we have for our students.

<u>Physical Education:</u> Sneakers (no platform soles, flip flops or slides), comfortable clothes. (if wearing a skirt or dress, wearing shorts under for class would be recommended. On swim days (grades 3-6), students will need a bathing suit (one piece for girls), a towel, and a bag for wet clothing.

<u>Kindergarten:</u> Mrs. Abers & Mrs. Caskey: Pencils, crayons (24 pack or smaller), erasers (not pencil toppers), scissors, at least 10 glue sticks, a set of thin dry erase markers, dry erase eraser or old sock, crayon box, art smock, 2 boxes of tissues, personal headphones/earbuds, box of non-slider Ziploc type bags – gallon size for girls & sandwich size for boys, 1 container of baby wipes, a change of clothes for accidents. Mrs. Abers: small mat/rug that can be rolled up (to sit on during independent work time)

<u>Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>: Mrs. Brown</u>: 3 boxes of tissues, 12 glue sticks, wipes (anti-bacterial or baby), dry erase markers (2 pack-preferably thin), an old sock, crayons, colored pencils, #2 pencils, erasers, 1 pair of scissors, white school glue, plastic pencil box, 1 plastic purple folders, 2 plastic folders (any color), headphones, 1 art smock (an old shirt of mom or dad's works great). Also, change of clothes to keep in your locker.

<u>First Grade:</u> Mrs. Egan, Ms. Kelly & Mrs. Lindquist: 2 Glue sticks, 2 boxes of tissues, sneakers, pencils/erasers, scissors, highlighter, notebook (primary lined paper preferred), crayons, art smock or old shirt, 2 pocket folders (one red and one blue), supply box, one inch three ring binder, package of dividers (set of 5), package of sheet protectors (set of 10), pkg. of 8 dry erase markers and an old sock, 1 set of ear-buds.

<u>Second Grade</u>: Mrs. Mansfield & Mrs. Mathews: 25 pencils, 10 erasers, box of crayons (24 count), markers, highlighters, dry erase markers, dry erase eraser/sock, scissors, 20 glue sticks, 1 yellow folder with 2 pockets, 1 blue folder with 2 pockets, 1 red folder with 2 pockets, 1 purple folder with 2 pockets, 2 notebooks, headphones (please write names on them), art smock/old shirt, 2 boxes of tissues, Ziplock bags (gallon size for girls, quart size for boys).

Third Grade: Mrs. Garrison & Ms. Zyhowski: One 1 ½ inch binder, package of 5 dividers/tabs, 1 composition notebook (1-subject paper bound), 1 bottle of glue, tissue boxes, backpack, pencils, erasers (not pencil toppers), zippered pencil pouch with 3 holes (for binder), art smock or old big shirt, scissors, crayons (24 pack or smaller), dry erase marker and clean old sock to erase, wide-ruled loose-leaf paper, personal headphones or earbuds (with name on them), 3 highlighters: pink, yellow, and green

<u>Fourth Grade:</u> Mrs. Lewis, Mrs. Lyndsley & Mrs. Park: Pencils, scissors, glue sticks, crayons, 7 folders (with pockets), 3 composition notebooks, tissues, headphones, highlighters (yellow, pink, green), old shirt for art smock <u>Optional:</u> pencil case, extra erasers, colored pencils

Ms. Buss: back pack, 3 highlighters (green, pink, yellow), 2 packages post-it notes, 2 boxes of crayons (24 or less), 2 boxes of colored pencils (24 or less), 2 boxes of washable markers, 4 glue sticks, 1 box of #2 pencils, 2 packs of loose-leaf paper, 1 pencil box or pouch, 4 dry erase markers, 4 composition books, 5 different colored folders, 1 pack index cards, 1 box of zip lock bags (gallon or quart), 2 boxes tissues, 1 package of baby wipes, old shirt or smock, personal headphones.

<u>Fifth Grade:</u> Ms. Donato & Mr. Paterniti: 4 composition notebooks, 6 folders 2 pockets with prongs. (Green, Blue, Red, Orange) 1 for guidance, 1 for "Take Home Folder", 2 packages of wide ruled paper, 2 packages of Ticonderoga pencils, 1 mix pack of pens (red, blue and black), 1 package of pink erasers (not pencil top), 1 package of highlighters (need: yellow, green, pink), 1 package each of Crayola crayons/colored pencils, 6 glue/glue sticks, 1 pair of scissors, 2 boxes of tissues, 2 pack of post-it notes, 2 packs of index cards, 1 pair of personal headphones (Preferably not earbuds)

<u>Sixth Grade:</u> Mr. Daly-Griffen, Mrs. Hayes & Mrs. Raetz: Pencils, erasers, 4 notebooks, 6 folders, highlighters (green, yellow, pink), colored pencils, post-it notes (one small pack), Kleenex, scissors, glue stick, expo markers, 1 box/bag to hold materials in desk, personal headphones/earbuds.

4th/5th/6th Music Class: notebook, pen & pencil, folder for worksheets (can be part of a multi-class binder)

4<sup>th</sup> /5<sup>th</sup> /6<sup>th</sup> Guidance Class: 2 folders with pockets.
