## Pine Valley Elementary School Supply List 2019-2020 Grades K-6

The following is a <u>general</u> list of supplies by grade level. Individual teachers may require additional supplies and if that is the case, parents will be notified by the teacher. Don't forget to <u>label everything</u>. NO TRAPPER KEEPERS – Desk openings are only 4" high and will not accommodate them. Please remember this when purchasing pencil/supply boxes as well. **Book bags on wheels have become popular, however, most do not fit into the size lockers we have for our students.** 

<u>Physical Education:</u> Students need gym shoes. Gym shoes should be athletic shoes that tie tightly to the students' feet, not "fashion" sneakers (no platform soles). Comfortable clothing should be worn on gym days. If a student chooses to wear a dress or skirt, a pair of shorts worn under would be okay. On swim days (grades 3-6), students will need a bathing suit (one piece for girls), a towel. No glass containers are to be taken to the pool or locker room area.

<u>Kindergarten:</u> Mrs. Garrison: Pencils, crayons (24 pack or smaller), erasers (not pencil toppers), scissors, at least 10 glue sticks, a set of thin dry erase markers, dry erase eraser or old sock, crayon box, art smock, 2 boxes of tissues, personal headphones/earbuds, box of non-slider Ziploc type bags – gallon size for girls & sandwich size for boys, 1 container of baby wipes, a change of clothes for accidents. "Please label all of your child's supplies".

Mrs. Mansfield's class: 1 plastic folder, 2 small pencil boxes, pencils, no pencil sharpeners, crayons, erasers, scissors, lots of glue sticks, a set of thin dry erase markers, art smock, a pair of headphones (that fit, no ear buds), a change of clothes for accidents. "Please label all of your child's supplies".

1st and 2nd Mrs. Brown: 3 boxes of tissues, 12 glue sticks, wipes (anti-bacterial or baby), dry erase markers (2 pack of thin), an old sock, crayons, markers, #2 pencils, erasers, 1 pair of scissors, white school glue, plastic pencil box, 1 plastic purple folder, 2 plastic folders (any color), headphones/earbuds, 1 art smock (an old shirt of mom or dad's works great). Also, change of clothes to keep in your locker

<u>First Grade:</u> Mrs. Grandits & Mrs. Raetz: 2 Glue sticks, 2 boxes of tissues, sneakers, pencils/erasers, scissors (Fiskars preferred), highlighter, notebook (primary lined paper preferred), book bag, 24 pack of crayons, art smock or old shirt, 2 pocket folders, supply box, pkg. of 8 dry erase markers and an old sock, 1 set of ear-buds.

Second Grade: Mrs. Caskey & Ms. Kelly – pencils (a lot!), colored pencils or crayons, erasers (a lot!), highlighters, scissors, glue sticks (a lot), 1 liquid glue bottle, dry erase markers, dry erase eraser/sock, 1 inch binder, package of dividers (set of 5), package of 10 sheet protectors, plastic clipboard (without bungee cords), 1 yellow folder with 2 pockets, 1 blue folder with 2 pockets, 1 red folder with 2 pockets, 1 purple folder with 2 pockets, 1 red notebook, 1 blue notebook, personal headphones (with name on them), smock or old shirt, 2 tissue boxes, Ziplock bags (gallon size for girls, quart size for boys)

<u>Third Grade:</u> Mrs. Lewis & Mrs. Lyndsley: Pencils/erasers, crayons, glue sticks, crayon or pencil box, scissors, 3 composition notebooks (1-subject paper bound), 1 box of tissues, book bag, 5 pocket folders, art smock or old shirt from mom or dad.

<u>Fourth Grade:</u> Mrs. Park & Mrs. Wulf: Scissors, 4 one subject notebooks, pencils, small bottle of glue, pencil cap erasers, pencil box, ruler, box of tissues to share, blue ink pens, dry erase markers, highlighters, colored pencils, old clean sock, personal headphones, any color sharpie, wide ruled loose-leaf notebook paper, vinyl folders with 3 prongs and 2 pockets in the following colors: blue, red, green, orange, and purple.

Mrs. Fleischmann: Tissues, dry erase markers, glue sticks, pencils, crayons and colored pencils.

<u>Fifth Grade:</u> Mrs. Abers & Mrs. Mathews:  $2\sim1$ " binders, 2 spiral notebooks, 1 single subject, wide ruled notebook, 4-2 basic 2 pocket folders, filler paper (an endless supply), continued supply of pencils, erasers, highlighters, crayons/colored pencils, glue/glue sticks, scissors,  $2\sim$ boxes of tissues, 1 pack of post-it notes, 2 packs of index cards, and personal headphones.

Sixth Grade: Mrs. Donato & Mrs. Egan: 1~2" binder, filler paper (an endless supply), dividers (at least 4), 4 notebooks (student choice), 4 folders for holding papers, pencils, colored pencils, erasers, highlighters (yellow, green, & pink), crayons, glue/glue sticks, scissors, 2~boxes of tissues, and personal hand sanitizer, index cards, post-it notes, and headphones or ear buds.

4th/5th/6th Music Class: notebook, pen & pencil, folder for worksheets (can be part of a multi-class binder)

4th /5th /6th Guidance Class: Students are expected to come to class each week prepared with the following supplies: Two 2 pocket folders (One for weekly class and one back-up folder for replacement mid-year as the original gets tattered), markers and/or crayons, and 2 pencils.

5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> Band: Purchase of own lesson book: Standard of Excellence Book 1. For clarinet/saxophone players: box of reeds (strength 2 or 2.5) Remember to check your child's supplies often and replenish as needed!!!
