Wall of Fame Induction Ceremony

On Sunday, June 29, 2014, the fifth Pine Valley Central School District Wall of Fame Induction Ceremony was held at the Pine Valley Central Jr./Sr. High School Library at 11:00 am. This year's inductees were Thomas Allnatt and Kyle Sticek. The purpose of this program is to honor graduates from Pine Valley Central School, living or deceased, who have distinguished themselves in a specific field of endeavor, in civic affairs, in humanitarian affairs, or in activities which merit special recognition.

Thomas Allnatt, *Class of 1974:* Tom served four years in the US Army and at Ft. Knox, Kentucky as a Surgical Assistant. At the completion of his enlistment he transferred to the Colorado Air National Guard in Denver, Colorado, received his commission and completed Air Force undergraduate Pilot Training. After completing advanced training in the A7 Corsair, he returned to his squadron and served until his military retirement in 1994. During that time he completed Advanced Flight Lead Training and Instructor Pilot Training in the A7 and then transitioned to fly the F16 where he won the squadron Top Gun Award in 1993. In the late 1980's Tom was appointed and served on the Military Academy Advisory Board for US Representative Dan Schaefer of Colorado. In 1985 Tom was hired at Continental Airlines as second officer in the DC10. Later he upgraded to First Officer on the MD80. In 1994 he upgraded to Captain and has flown in command of the McDonald Douglas MD80 as well as Boeing B737, B757, B767 and B777 aircraft.

Kyle Sticek, *Class of 1991:* Kyle is currently employed by Harris Corporation – Harris IT Services. In support of their long-standing commitment to the Department of State – Bureau of Consular Affairs – Office of Consular Systems and Technology, Kyle satisfies contract deliverables and reporting requirements in accordance with strict expectations and technical specifications. He serves as a subject matter expert for all consular systems employed at U.S. diplomatic missions - this includes studying systems integration of the consular systems with screening mechanisms including name checks against government lookout databases and biometric checks by facial recognition and fingerprint analysis. To accomplish mission tasks, Kyle consults with a range of Department of State diplomatic ranks including Consul Generals, Consuls, Directors, Branch Chiefs and Information Management Officers. Kyle also acts in support of training initiatives at the Department of State's National Foreign Affairs Training Center – Foreign Service Institute.
