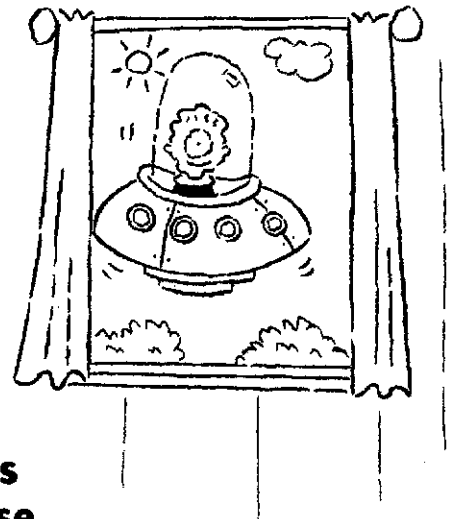
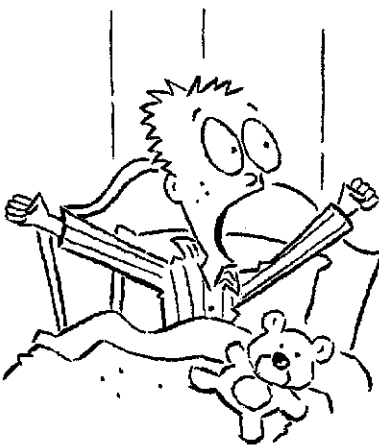
## November Choice Board Grades 3-6
