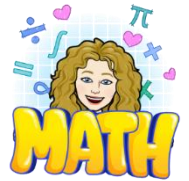

What We're Learning

ELA: Readers' Workshop: Building reading stamina with individual books, Reading to teacher 1:1 to find current reading level, Word Work: homophones, prefixes, suffixes. Class Read Aloud: Magic Tree House: Knight at Dawn



Math: Students apply properties of multiplication and use the relationship between multiplication and division to solve problems.



Social Studies: Geographic region characteristics. Describing different world communities and comparing by asking, What makes places similar and different?



Science: Animals Through Time- Fossils, Animal Survival, & Heredity students develop an understanding of how animals and their environments change through time.
