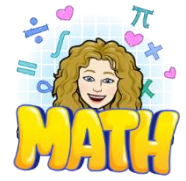


What We're Learning



ELA: Readers' Workshop: Building reading stamina with individual books, Reading to teacher 1:1 to find current reading level, Word Work: homophones, prefixes

Math: Understand multiplication and division of whole numbers. Students are introduced to multiplication and division. They use patterns to solve multiplication.

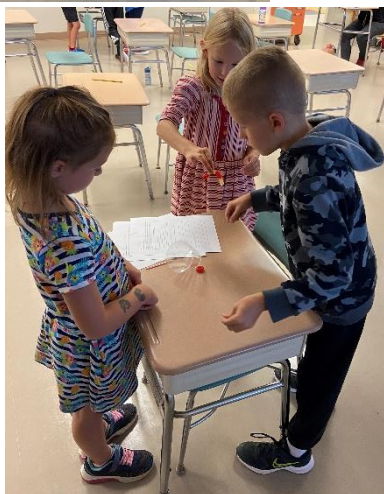


Social Studies: Geographic region characteristics. Describing different world communities and comparing by asking What makes places similar and different?

Saving Fred STEM experiment



Fred, the gummy worm, has been spending his time boating on the lake near his home. He is not too bright; he is a worm after all. He has never learned to swim, and he never wears his life preserver. The worst has finally happened! Fred's boat has capsized, and he is stuck! His life preserver (gummy life saver) is caught under the boat (clear plastic cup), but he cannot reach it without falling into the water and drowning.
