School's out, summer is upon us, let Summer Reading begin! The Member Libraries of the Chautauqua-Cattaraugus Library System will be offering their Summer Reading Programs but in a very different way this year – *it will be virtual!*

Online Registration – Many of our libraries will be using an online Summer Reading registration program called READSquared. Go the library's webpage to find their Summer Reading link. Register for your age program and log your reading, earn points, play games, go on missions, and write reviews – whatever your library has set up for you. Get a certificate when you earn all the points! Then keep on earning points!

There are a few of programs everyone can participate in through CCLS:

- **Adults and Teens** each have their own Book Review Program on the CCLS READSquared site - <https://cclsny02.readsquared.com/> Register and post book reviews to be entered into a drawing for a gift certificate at the end of the summer.
- **Music Class with Alyssa!** Fun music lessons for kids designed by a music therapist will have you singing and moving and creating your own versions of the songs.
 - Put some beans in a water bottle to shake, grab a scarf or washcloth to wave, use a wooden spoon and pot as a drum and make lots of fun music along with Alyssa.
