1. Ring-necked Identified by its bright yellow belly and distinct yellow collar behind its head.
2. Brown Recognized by its greyish brown to drab brown black with two longitudinal rows of small dark spots.
3. Red-bellied Ranging in color from brown to reddish brown, or tan to grey.
4. short-headed garter Identified by its narrow head that is scarcely wider than its neck.
5. common garter A larger cousin of the short-headed garter.
6. Northern Water Moderately heavy-bodied snake with irregular reddish brown bands across its lighter-colored back.
7. Milk Proportionately slender, with greyish-white bodies that have a series of reddish-brown blotches with black edges.
