This letter is to inform you and your child what is expected of them this semester in my Technology class. You may know Technology as Industrial Arts or Shop Class; the name has changed to keep up with our ever-changing world. Many of the hands on activities from Industrial Arts remain however items such as problem solving and design activities have been added. GRADING:

Final grades are determined by the following breakdown.

BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS:

- 1. Come to class on time and prepared for class. No one will be allowed to leave for materials, which should be present once class has started.
- 2. Treat other students and teacher with respect.
