BUILDING NUMBER SENSE

Primary students will gradually build number sense in each of these areas. When students struggle with early addition and subtraction, there could be a breakdown in one of these areas.

One to One Tagging

touching the object and giving it a number to keep track

Cardinality

Knowing that the last number said in the counting sequence is the answer of "How Many?"

Subitizing

Ability to see how many without counting.
ex: saying five when you see all fingers up on one hand.

Counting On

keep one addend whole and count on
