Proposition #1 – Basic Budget - \$15,010,210 budget

Shall the budget for the year 2015-2016 as approved by the Board of Education be adopted and the required funds therefore be raised by a tax on the taxable property of the school district? (includes cost of Proposition 3)

Proposition #2 - Transportation Vehicle Reserve Fund

Shall the Board of Education be authorized to establish a capital reserve fund to be known as the Transportation Vehicle Reserve Fund for the purpose of purchasing vehicles to be used in the transportation program of the District. The ultimate amount of such Fund shall not be greater than \$1.2 million plus interest thereon; the probable term of such Fund shall be not later than July 1, 2025; the source of the monies for the Fund shall be the unappropriated fund balance of the District.

Proposition #3 - Purchase of Buses

Shall the Board of Education be authorized to purchase school buses (and related equipment) for use in the transportation program of the district at a maximum estimated cost of \$212,000 after trade-ins, and raise the required funds by a tax on the taxable property of the school district.

Proposition #4 - Reduce Seats on Board of Education

Shall the number of seats on the Board of Education be reduced from nine to seven? The position of school board member is non-compensated.

Proposition #5 - Student Representative

Shall a student be selected pursuant to Section 1804(12) of the New York Education Law as an ex officio member of the Board of Education of the Pine Valley Central School District, and that such ex officio member shall be entitled to a) sit with the board members at all public meetings of the board, and b) participate in all board hearings and meetings, but shall not a) have a vote, b) be allowed to attend executive session, or c) be entitled to receive compensation of any form for participating at board meetings, and shall be subject to the further terms and conditions of Section 1804(12) of the Education Law.
