Superintendent’s Report:

- The Lockdown Facts-On Friday, October 7, 2022, Deputy Hite contacted me and stated that there was a man with a long gun on Route 83, near the school. He stated that the man was despondent and threatening violence, then he advised us to go into lockdown. Later we learned, the man was 4 miles away from the school and we should have gone into a lockout, rather than a lockdown. During the lockdown we had students at our afterschool program, as well as, students that stayed after for sports. We have learned from this experience and decided there is a need to have a greater discussion with students, so we can explain what a lockdown means, go over the procedures, and help them better understand the process.

- The admin team attended the Music Banquet last night with Shawn Huestis, Mary Kay Himes and Alex Peterson. It was a wonderful event and we had a great time.
- Mary Kay and Lisa Kelley are mapping out a Music Summer Camp that would take place during our Summer Enrichment program. We would pay these extra duty positions through a MOA and adjust the stipends to be comparable to that of coaches. We would need to increase the stipends for the following positions: Director of Drama; Assistant Drama Director; Producer; and Musical Conductor.
- Wrestling-There is a 12th grader that would like to wrestle his senior year at Gowanda. I need guidance from the board on this topic. Would you like me to pursue this? Adding a sport this late in the school year could pull students from already established sport teams. We did have a shared agreement previously for wrestling.
- J. Chase-We have already established our shared athletic sports teams for the 2022-2023 school year. We determined what shared athletics sports we would like to pursue at our reorganizational meeting. This decision would violate section 6 rules. Currently, if we pursue adding wrestling, we need to be willing to pursue other sports. *The entire board was in agreeance that currently they do not wish to pursue a Shared Athletic Sports Merger for Wrestling. The board reiterated that they are happy to consider ALL new sports opportunities again for this coming year.*
- Our Board Meeting will be moved from Thursday, November 10 to Thursday, November 17 at 6:00p.m., in the Elementary School Library. We will interview prospective board members during open session. Then nominate, second and with a majority vote elect a new board member that evening.
