ACTION/OTHER ITEMS

- Authorized the declaration of damaged or unusable iPad2s as presented as surplus and approved appropriate disposal and their removal from District inventory reports where required.
- Approved the following donations from the Community in Action group:

- Accepted the insurance proposal of NYSIR (New York Schools Insurance Reciprocal) Uniondale, New York, as presented for the 2018-19 school year.
- Approved the Shared Athletic Program Agreement for Varsity Wrestling with Fredonia Central School for the 2018-19 school year and directed and authorized the Superintendent to sign said agreement on behalf of the District.
- Approved the Shared Athletic Program Agreement for Modified Wrestling with Silver Creek Central School for the 2018-19 school year and directed and authorized the Superintendent to sign said agreement on behalf of the District.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- **State Math Assessments:** Kelly Zimmerman reported that students in grades 3-5 took paper tests. Majority of students were done within timeframe. Good feedback received from teachers that the questions were fair. Kelly Wetzler reported that the 6th graders took the computer-based assessments with students loving this method better than paper testing. Teachers did a great job of practicing with students prior to testing. John Sheffield reported that the 7th & 8th graders took the paper assessments and that this was the last year as they will take computer-based assessments next year. By 2021 all students in New York State need to take the computer-based assessments. Each local district has been allowed to decide how best to roll that out.
- John and Scott reported that 40 individuals will be participating as presenters in the **Career Fair** on May 9th with a good cross section of professional and trades represented as well as the military.

BOARD REPORTS (committee, conference/training, extracurricular event – i.e. sports, play)

- **Finance Committee** – Pat reported earlier in the meeting that they had met and discussed the property and casualty insurance carrier proposals.
- **Transportation Committee** – Jackie reported that they met to discuss passenger size for bus purchases and reviewed quotes from multiple vendors. Our district will purchase 66-passenger buses since they are more versatile for overall use with only a small increase in price from smaller buses.
- Scott, Kelly Zimmerman, Pat Krenzer and Christie Lokietek will be attending the **Rural Schools Conference** at Cooperstown in July.
- **Technology Committee** – Scott, Kelly Wetzler, Rex, Dave and Pat reported on the technology programs they viewed at Bemus Point Elementary, Gowanda, Grand Island and Erie 1 BOCES last week.
- Larry reported that he heard on the news that assembly woman Rosenthal has proposed a bill to ban **rifle clubs and archery** from schools. The Board of Education directed the District Clerk to write a letter to our State Assembly Representatives and State Senator opposing the bill introduced by Assemblymember Linda Rosenthal that would ban rifle clubs and archery in schools.
