### **Acting Superintendent's Report:**

- A brief update on the progress being made on the Capital Project:
  - The scaffolding in the pool area was installed, men wore scuba gear to enter the pool because the temperature of the water was 50 degrees.
  - The installation of drainage on the football field is coming along nicely.
  - The floor in the old High School Gymnasium was ripped out in 2 days and the crew is hard at work replacing it.
  - The concrete floor in the Elementary Locker Room is being poured this weekend.
- Dave VanZile, Jamie Rodgers and I attended a Zoom meeting with Solar Liberty, to explore having solar panels added to the school. At this time, we are awaiting their cost analysis to gain a better understanding of whether it would be cost efficient and what the benefits for the District would be in the long run.
- An update on graduation, if it rains on both Saturday and Sunday, then the ceremony will be held inside the High School on Sunday at 11:00 AM. Graduates can have 2 guests in attendance at the event if it is indoors.
- This morning nine Seniors left on their senior trip to the Thousand Islands and they will return to the school on Saturday at 8:00 PM.

### **J. Rodgers:**

- Quotes for landscaping the front of the High School have come in and we have two options:
  - The first proposal would remove all shrubs and bushes, start over with new fill and all new plants. This quote will cost approximately \$10,000 to rip everything out and start fresh.
  - The second option would incorporate any bushes that still looked nice, remove the dead shrubs and add a few new smaller plants and trees to freshen up the look of the building. This quote came in at just above \$5000.

We would like to have the work done now, so that the front of the building looks nice for graduation. \* The board choose the second option.

- Three quotes to repair the Steinway piano have come in and are as follows:
  - The first quote was for \$11,000, but the reviews were not wonderful.
  - The second quote was for \$19,000, but the mahogany finish would be made black.
  - The third and final quote was for \$19,500 and the repairs would be made while leave the mahogany finish. Furthermore, he will loan us a piano for use next 2021-2022 school year, while repairs are being made.

We have budgeted \$20,000 for repairs, the cost of a new Steinway piano ranges \$75,000-\$140,000. \* The board choose the third option.

- The BAN results are very favorable, the interest rate is 1.25% with a net rate of .2708%.
- The End of Year BOE Picnic will be held on June 24<sup>th</sup> starting at 11:30. Kara Frontuto, Larry Zollinger possibly and Christie Lokietek have volunteered to serve hotdogs that day.
