Panther families you might qualify for a temporary FCC program that offers COVID relief discounts of up to \$50 per month off your internet bill. Check it out at GetEmergencyBroadband.org. The FCC is also changing the way to dial into our area. You will need to dial the area code 716 to reach our school.

Beginning October 24, 2021, consumers must dial 10-digits (area code + telephone number) for all local calls. On and after this date, local calls dialed with only 7 digits may not be completed, and a recording will inform you that your call cannot be completed as dialed. Consumers must hang up and dial again using the area code and the 7-digit number. Beginning July 16, 2022, dialing "988" will route calls to the helpline.
